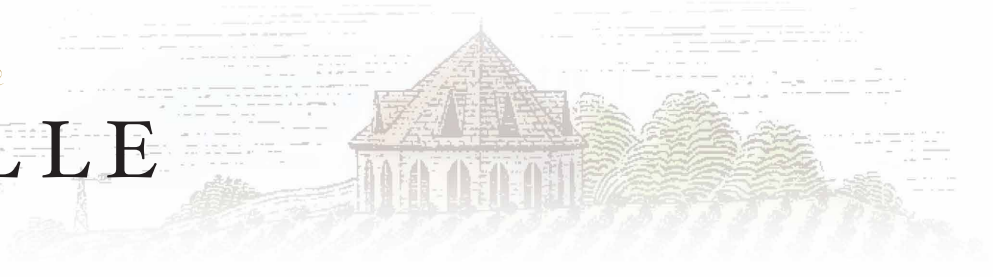

BACKGROUND

Chardonnay, the noble grape of White Burgundy, is among the most popular and widely planted of all grape varieties, producing high quality dry white table wines throughout the world. Partial to cool-climate growing regions, it thrives in the high-altitude vineyards of Idaho's Snake River Valley.

WINEMAKING

The 2009 vintage enjoyed a balanced growing season with plenty of good weather. The grapes were picked at a perfect ripeness and the juice partially fermented in oak barrels to achieve a rounder, smoother texture.

WINE DESCRIPTION

Our Chardonnay is made in an approachable fruit-forward style with just a touch of vanillin oak.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Pairs well with grilled or broiled seafood, roast chicken and mild cheeses.
