

# STE CHAPELLE



## 2014 SRV SAUVIGNON BLANC

### BACKGROUND

Founded in 1975, Ste. Chapelle winery was named after the beautiful La Sainte Chapelle in Paris, which was built by Louis IX as the court chapel during the 13th century. The Snake River Valley's high altitude vineyards, which enjoy long daylight hours, warm summer days and crisp evenings, supply Ste. Chapelle with superior grapes for its award-winning wines.

### VINTAGE NOTE

The 2014 vintage was marked by a warm summer with warm days and cool but frost-free nights in September and October. This allowed our Sauvignon Blanc grapes to come to complete ripeness while still retaining their crisp acidity. We picked grapes from the Webb Vineyard and Skyline Vineyard for our 2014 blend and fermented the juice in stainless steel to preserve the ripe fruit flavors.

### WINE DESCRIPTION

Aromas of lavender, lime and grapefruit. Ripe flavors of citrus, white peaches and pineapple. Crisp acidity and a lingering finish.
